

Courtaulds Culvert, Bovingdon Road, Bocking

An emergency closure of Bovingdon Road was required in September 2016 after an inspection found Courtaulds Culvert, which runs beneath the carriageway, to be suffering from serious deterioration. The closure remains in place in the interests of public safety until structural works are undertaken.

We will continue to maintain an access route for pedestrians and dismounted cyclists.

A programme of work has been determined to demolish and reconstruct a section of the culvert that falls within the highway boundary. Structural works are due to commence summer 2017, with an anticipated completion date of autumn 2017.

We are liaising with a number of third parties, including utility suppliers regarding service supplies that run close to or through the structure.

Some diversions to supplies will be necessary at the beginning of the works.
