**The Essex County Council Definitive Map Modification No. 684
(Footpaths 41, 42 and 43 Henham, Uttlesford District) Order 2021**

This Order is made by Essex County Council under Section 53(2)(b) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 "the Act" because it appears to the Secretary of State (who has directed the authority to that effect) that the Definitive Map and Statement for the County of Essex requires modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in Section 53(3)(c)(i) namely, the discovery by the authority of evidence which (when considered with all other relevant evidence available to them) shows (i) that a right of way which is not shown in the map and statement subsists or is reasonably alleged to subsist over land in the area to which the map relates, being a right of way to which this Part applies.

The authority has consulted with every local authority whose area includes the land to which the order relates. The Essex County Council hereby order that:

1. For the purpose of this order the relevant date is 06 October 2021.
2. The Definitive Map and Statement for the County of Essex shall be modified as described in Part I and Part II of the Schedule and shown on the map attached to the Order.
3. This order shall take effect on the date it is confirmed and may be cited as the Essex County Council Definitive Map Modification No.684 (Footpaths 41, 42 and 43 Henham, Uttlesford District) Order 2021.

PART I

Modification of Definitive Map

Description of path or way to be added

1. A length of public footpath numbered 41 Henham, from Footpath 2 at Point A on the order plan in a generally northerly direction for a distance of approximately 175 metres to Point C at the Vernons Road play area.
2. A length of public footpath number 42 Henham from Footpath 4 at point D on the order plan in a generally westerly direction for a distance of approximately 188 metres to Point F at the Vernons Road play area.
3. A length of public footpath numbered 43 Henham from Footpath 41 at Point B on the order plan in a generally north easterly direction for a distance of approximately 112 metres to join Footpath 42 at point E.

Modifications of Definitive Statement

The statement for the parish of Henham shall be amended by the addition of the following : -

TL52 NW	41	FP	From Footpath 2 in a generally northerly direction for a distance of approximately 175 metres to the Vernons Road play area. The width of the way is 2 metres.
TL52 NW	42	FP	From Footpath 4 in a generally westerly direction for a distance of approximately 188 metres to the Vernons Road play area. The width of the way is 2 metres
TL52NW	43	FP	From Footpath 41 in a generally north easterly direction for a distance of approximately 112 metres to join Footpath 42. The width of the way is 2 metres.

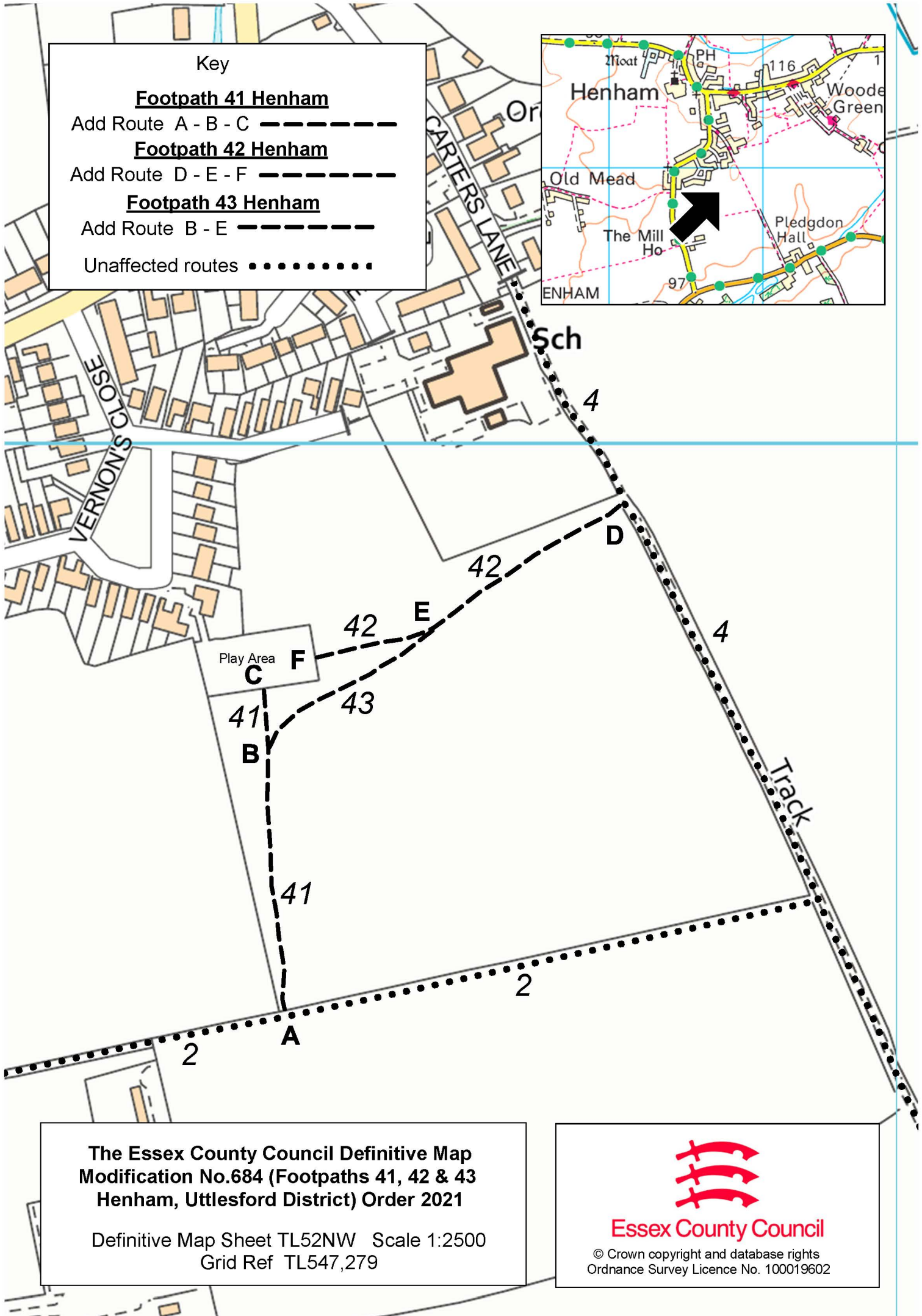
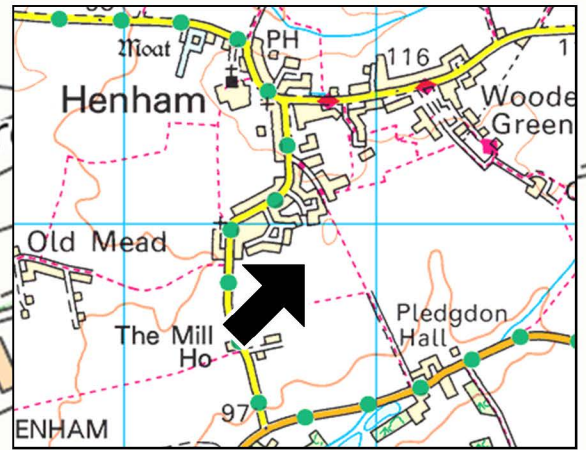
