# The Essex County Council Definitive Map Modification No. 698 (Bridleway 202 Brentwood, Brentwood Borough) Order 2023

This Order is made by Essex County Council under Section 53(2)(b) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 "the Act" because it appears to that authority that the Definitive Map and Statement for the County of Essex requires modification in consequence of the occurrence of events specified in Section 53(3)(c)(i) &(ii) namely, the discovery by the authority of evidence which (when considered with all other relevant evidence available to them) shows (i) that a right of way which is not shown in the map and statement subsists or is reasonably alleged to subsist over land in the area to which the map relates, being a right of way to which this Part applies and (ii) that a highway shown in the map and statement as a highway of a particular description ought to be there shown as a highway of a different description.

The authority has consulted with every local authority whose area includes the land to which the order relates. The Essex County Council hereby order that:

For the purpose of this order the relevant date is 26 April 2023.

The Definitive Map and Statement for the County of Essex shall be modified as described in Part I and Part II of the Schedule and shown on the map attached to the Order.

This order shall take effect on the date it is confirmed and may be cited as the Essex County Council Definitive Map Modification No.698 (Bridleway 202 Brentwood, Brentwood Borough) Order 2023.

#### PART I

# Modification of Definitive Map Description of path or way to be added

- 1. A length of public bridleway numbered 202 from Warley Road at Point A on the order plan (opposite the Thatchers Arms) in a generally southerly direction along Hole Farm Lane (also known as Pilgrims Way) for a distance of 753 metres to the Point B where Footpath 110b joins the route from the west. The width of this section of the route is 2.8 metres.
- 2. An additional length of public bridleway numbered 202 along Hole Farm Lane (also known as Pilgrims Way) from its junction with Footpath 110a at Hole Farm (Point C on the Order plan) in a generally southerly direction for a distance of 695 metres to Point D where it meets the public road at Codham Hall Lane. The width of this section of the way is 3 metres.

## Description of path to be upgraded

1. A length of Footpath 110 Brentwood from Point B on the order plan, in a generally southerly direction for a distance of 278 metres to Point C, is upgraded to public bridleway. The width of this section of the way is 2.8 metres.


#### Variations of particulars of path or way

The statement for the Borough of Brentwood shall be amended as follows: -

OS Sheet No.	Path No.	Classification	Position and Description
59 SE and 58 NE	202	BR	From Warley Road (opposite the Thatchers Arms) in a generally southerly direction for a distance of approximately 1726 metres to the public road at Codham Hall Lane.  The width of the northerly 1031 metres of the way, (to the junction with Footpath 110a) is 2.8 metres, increasing to 3 metres for the remaining 695 metres to Codham Hall Lane.

58 NE	110a	FP	From Great Warley Street in a south-westerly direction for a distance of approximately 479 metres to meet Bridleway 202 at Hole Farm.
58 NE	110b	FP	From Bridleway 202 in a generally westerly and southerly direction for a distance of approximately 838 metres to join Beredens Lane.
