## Active Travel Essex - Brentwood

### Implementation of Speed Table – Highland Avenue and Sawyers Hall Lane (Brentwood North) in the Borough of Brentwood

**Notice is hereby given** that under Section 90A-F of the Highways Act 1980 and The Highways (Road Humps) Regulations 1999, Essex County Council proposes to install a 'Speed Table' on the following lengths of road in the Borough of Brentwood as detailed below.

**Effect of the changes:** To introduce a Speed Table on Highland Avenue and Sawyers Hall Lane:

**To Introduce:** 'Speed Table'.

Road	Description
Highland Avenue	From its junction with Sawyers Hall Lane, south westwards for approximately 12.5 metres.
Sawyers Hall Lane	From a point approximately 3 metres north west of the boundary of 34 Highland Avenue, north westwards for approximately 24 metres.

The maximum height of the proposed Speed Table is approximately 75 millimetres, and is carriageway width, with a ramp gradient of no greater than approximately 1:20
